What is being proposed?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a draft Post-Closure Permit for the former Land Treatment Area (LTA) at Phillips 66 Company, San Francisco Refinery, 1380 San Pablo Avenue, Rodeo, California, 94572. DTSC is the state agency responsible for regulating the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. If approved, the 10-year post-closure permit would require long-term monitoring and maintenance of the LTA.

As part of the permit process, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed draft post-closure permit as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption in connection with this project. **The public comment period will run from September 6, 2016 through October 24, 2016.** Written comments must be postmarked or emailed by **October 24, 2016** and sent to: Mike Eshaghian, Project Manager, 9211 Oakdale Avenue, Chatsworth, California 91311, Mike.Eshaghian@dtsc.ca.gov.
