Facility Permit Renewal to Continue operations of 8 existing hazardous waste management units and one proposed roll-off bin solid waste management unit. Rho-Chem routinely stores and treats its halogenated and non-halogenated waste solvents more than 90 days. Rho-Chem recycles spent solvents which are brought into the facility and transferred into aboveground tanks, redistilled, and resold. These spent solvents may be a mixture of a wide range of halogenated, oxygenated, aromatic and aliphatic solvents. Residues from the distillation process are sent off-site for appropriate disposal. Rho-Chem Limited Liability Corporation, a subsidiary of PSC, is the owner and operator of the site. The facility is located at 425 Isis Avenue in the City of Inglewood, County of Los Angeles.

As Lead Agency a Responsible Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC approved the above-described project on [date] and has made the following determinations:
