The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is providing this notice to inform the public of a hazardous waste permit renewal application for Southern California Gas Company, Olympic Hazardous Waste Management Facility (SoCal Gas), located at 2424 E. Olympic Blvd., Los Angeles, California 90021. The application is a request from SoCal Gas to renew its Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit to store hazardous waste generated from both on-site and by off-site SoCal Gas activities. DTSC is reviewing the application to ensure their operations continue to meet the technical and regulatory requirements in order to protect human health and the environment.

The SoCal Gas Company's Olympic Hazardous Waste Management Facility, currently stores wastes containing PCBs that are generated on and off site. The wastes are generated during routine removal of accumulated condensate liquids from natural gas pipeline systems and cleaning of pipelines. Also, there are solid PCB- wastes which are contaminated equipment (including but not limited to, gas meters, pressure regulators and gas dryers), contaminated protective clothing, soil absorbents, and other PCB-contaminated liquids, and a small portion of that fluorescent light ballasts. These PCB wastes are collected and stored in a single storage building and two outdoor concrete storage pads with secondary containment.

The Hazardous Waste Permit Renewal Application request no changes to the current permitted storage and treatment activities. The public will be notified when DTSC releases a draft of the proposed permit for public review and comment.


