Dear Mr. Hussain:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed its review of the proposed Class 1 permit modification (Modification #34) requested originally in a letter dated June 26, 2006. This request modifies Veolia's current Hazardous Waste Facility Permit issued on December 29, 1989.

Modification #34 entails the following item: An administrative modification to change the names of the facility, owner, and operator from Onyx Environmental Services, L.L.C. to Veolia ES Technical Solutions L.L.C. The modification is for a change in facility, owner, and operator names only and will not affect the ownership or the operational control of the facility. No conditions of the facility's hazardous waste permit will change.

In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.42, Veolia must send a public notice of the proposed modification to all persons on the facility's mailing list and the relevant appropriate entities of state and local government. The notification was published in the San Gabriel Valley Tribune newspaper on November 16, 2007.
