

DTSC cannot consider arguments that do not meet the content and filing requirements stated in the Order Granting Review. Both mailed and e-mailed briefs should include a return e-mail address to facilitate communications with interested parties. After considering submitted written arguments, DTSC will issue an order with the final permit decision.

Persons who submit written arguments may also request that DTSC hold an Informal Appeals Conference, so that they may also present their arguments orally. If requested, DTSC may schedule the Informal Appeals Conference after the close of the briefing period. Interested members of the public who would like to be informed of the date, time, and location of the Informal Appeals Conference, if one is held by DTSC, are requested to contact DTSC at appeals@dtsc.ca.gov or call (916) 324-4754 to provide their contact information. The conference information will also be posted on the DTSC websites listed in this notice.
