

Goodman Global, Inc. ("Goodman"), is aware of the position taken by DTSC, that any further responses to the Summary of Violations ("SOV") dated July 3, 2014, must be submitted by October 10, 2014. At DTSC's request, Goodman has scheduled a call with your agency on October 13 to discuss the issues raised in the SOV with regard to Goodman, and we appreciate having this opportunity for a further dialogue. Goodman previously raised its concerns regarding the SOV in its letter to DTSC dated July 31, 2014, and has no further comments at this time. However, we realize the upcoming conference call on October 13 may raise or highlight additional issues and we reserve the right to submit further comments after our conference call and if so, would request that, even though DTSC has recently declined to extend the October 10 date for receiving comments, that any further comments would be considered by DTSC.
