

**Status of Treated Wood Waste
Alternative Management Standards Regulations
9/17/2007**

Full Rulemaking: Approved by Office of Administrative Law (OAL) on June 18, 2007

Effective Date: July 1, 2007

Emergency Regulations: Effective 5/1/07-6/30/07

OAL approved the Alternative Management Standards for Treated Wood Waste rulemaking and sent the approved package to the Secretary of State with a effective date of July 1, 2007. The emergency regulations became inoperative when the regulations for Alternative Management Standards took effect.

In order to revise the phrase “an approved landfill” to “TWW facility” in (a)(2)(B)3. of section 67386.6 of title 22, California Code of Regulations, DTSC withdrew this subparagraph in the July 1, 2007 version of the regulations. The revision is considered significant enough to require a 15 day renote of the revised language of this specific subparagraph. (See http://www.dtsc.ca.gov/LawsRegsPolicies/Regs/TWW_Proposed.cfm) The renote does not affect the adoption of the Alternative Management Standards for Treated Wood Waste rulemaking. As no comments were received during the public notice period 2007, DTSC expects the revised subparagraph language to be inserted into the regulations by November.
