Bill Greggs is an Associate Director in Procter & Gamble's Global Sustainability organization and has responsibility for number of policy issues including chemicals management initiatives and retailer sustainability.

Bill participates in Wal-Mart's Chemically Intensive Products Network and was a member of the NPPTAC Stakeholder Advisory Panel to US EPA OPPT. He is the chair of the Soap & Detergent Association's HPV Task Force, and served on in a number of HPV consortia. He is a member of the ACC's Health, Product and Science Policy Team and chair of the ACC Product Stewardship Team. He participated in development of the Council's proposals for assessment of chemicals in the VCCEP program and served on US EPA's VCCEP stakeholder panel. Bill was also active on the Communications Committee at the Alliance for Chemical Awareness, which developed a framework for presenting the results of screening level exposure assessments and participated in an OECD Task Force that developed a standardized approach for Use and Exposure reporting.

Bill joined P&G after receiving his BS in Chemical Engineering from Lafayette College in Easton, Pennsylvania in 1971 and worked in P&G manufacturing management positions for 20 years. Since 1990, Bill has had leadership responsibility for a number of legislative, regulatory and technical policy issues affecting the Company and its products, including solid waste management, product labeling, antimicrobial product registration, HPV programs, children's health, chemical policy and product safety information sharing.
