Information Summary

- ✓ Informal survey from Miller Park Marina (freshwater) showed approximately 60% of all boats displayed copper bottom paint (the majority with copper bottom paint were 21 feet or longer).
- ✓ Best Management Practices Manual in development stage.
- ✓ Coordinating with Marina Recreation Association on Pollution Prevention Week activities.
- ✓ Discussed possible contract concept for reimbursement to Marinas to encourage installation of used oil containers with the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB). CIWMB not interested in this contract concept but, possibly in purchasing waste oil collection signs for posting at marina sites.
- ✓ Begin identifying contacts within the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) and National Park Service concerning underwater hull cleaning issues.
