The Registered Environmental Assessor (REA) Program has broad authority to investigate and resolve complaints against a Registered Environmental Assessor I or II. Complaints may be filed against an REA for certain contractual, technical, safety, misrepresentation or fraud-related issues occurring during their performance of environmental activities.

The REA Program’s authority allows disciplinary actions consistent with the California Health and Safety Code Chapter 6.98, and California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 4.5, Chapter 52 (commencing with section 69200). Disciplinary actions may result in the suspension or revocation of registration. Pertinent sections of the California Health and Safety Code and the California Code of Regulations are available from the REA Program website, or are available in printed format from the REA Program.

Please note that all complaints will be carefully considered; however, the act of filing a complaint does not assure or imply that disciplinary action will be taken against a registrant. You will be notified of the disposition of this complaint.
