



Good Afternoon,

The Riverside Agricultural Park cleanup will begin Monday August 22, 2016 at 7:00 am. As previously indicated, DTSC staff will be onsite monitoring dust at all times during soil disturbance activities to ensure that the community is protected from dust.

We would also like to notify you of a change in the operational activities during the site cleanup. Due to logistical issues, there will be times when direct loading of trucks with excavated soil is not possible. DTSC has directed the developer that direct loading is the preferred method, however, when it is not possible, due to logistical issues, the developer must abide by the following protocol:

1. A staging area will be identified with the following criteria:
 - a. An area protected from winds (lower elevation);
 - b. Maximize distance from the prevailing downwind area of the Sites' fence line (generally the southeastern property line);
 - c. The area should be easily accessible by the water truck for dust mitigation purposes;
 - d. The area selected should minimize the travel distance between the excavated soil material and the truck loading area;
2. The staging area will be limited to a volume of excavated soil material which can be reasonably loaded in a single day;
3. The staging area will be adequately sprayed with water to ensure adequate dust suppression;
4. Excavated soil material will be completely covered with plastic sheeting and weighted down with sand-bags when excavation/loading activities are not taking place; and,
5. By the end of the work day on Friday each week, no excavated soil material will remain in the staging area.

DTSC looks forward to expediently removing the impacted soil while maintaining the necessary monitoring and precautionary measures to protect public health and

the environment during the process.
