

### ***Cleanup Loans and Environmental Assistance to Neighborhoods Loan Program***

In 2000, then-California Gov. Gray Davis signed into law the Cleanup Loans and Environmental Assistance to Neighborhoods (CLEAN) loan program ([Senate Bill 667](#)), establishing new financial incentives to encourage property owners, developers, community groups and local governments to redevelop abandoned and underused [urban properties](#) in California.

DTSC is not accepting loan applications currently but anticipates accepting them by late fall 2010.
