# Current Requirements

## Reoccupancy Standards

- 0.1 ug/100 sq. cm. – Methamphetamine
- 20 ug/ sq. ft. – Lead
- 50 ng/ cu. meter – Mercury

Ch. 6.9.1 25400.16 (a) (b) HSC

# Current Requirements

Statutory reoccupancy standards become inoperative when DTSC adopts with OEHHA's guidance a Methamphetamine Health-Based Target Remediation (Cleanup) Standard
