



**INTERIM REVISED REMOVAL ACTION WORKPLAN
FOR SOIL CLEANUP AT FMC CORPORATION, MODESTO IS APPROVED
AUGUST 2006**



The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has approved the draft Revised Interim Removal Action Work Plan (draft IRAW) for Soil at the FMC Corporation former manufacturing facility (called the Site), 1200 Graphics Drive, Modesto, California, 95351. From June 14 through July 14, 2006 a public comment period to accept comments on the draft IRAW was held. The project involves excavating soil contaminated with barium, arsenic, and polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons to levels which are protective of human health for commercial use; and soil containing total petroleum hydrocarbons to levels which are protective of human health and water quality. A total of approximately 3,100 cubic yards of contaminated soil will be excavated and transported to an authorized land fill for disposal.

As required under a State law called the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC determined that the cleanup qualifies for a Categorical Exemption (called a Notice of Exemption). A Notice of Exemption states that the project will not have a significant impact on the environment.

Comments received during the comment period were considered before DTSC made a decision to approve the draft IRAW. A Response to Comments was also prepared for this project. A Response to Comments is a document that lists all of the comments received during the comment period, and DTSC's response to those comments. A copy of the Response to Comments was sent to anyone who submitted a comment and is also located at the information repositories established for this project (please see below for repository location and information).
