FIELD WORK BEGINNING APRIL 19, 2012



The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about upcoming work at the Golden Technology Site located at 3017, 3019, and 3033 Santa Rosa Avenue in a mixed commercial and residential area in south Santa Rosa, California.

WHAT WORK WILL BE DONE?

The work is being performed to implement the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) for Groundwater, which was approved by the DTSC on June 29, 2010. Past activities at the site resulted in contaminated groundwater. The contaminants are trichloroethylene (TCE) and cis-1, 2-dichloroethene (DCE); both are volatile organic compounds (VOCs). To encourage a natural degradation process, a Hydrogen Release Compound (HRC) and anaerobic microbes will be injected into shallow groundwater. HRC, a carbon source, and the microbes will stimulate microbial growth to break down the contaminants. This is a natural process known as reductive dechlorination, which degrades VOCs in to a non-harmful substance.

Work is expected to begin on April 19, 2012 and continue through May 11, 2012, and will be done during normal business hours (8:00 AM to 5:00 PM), Monday through Friday. Work activities will include the following:

- Approximately 105 subsurface injections of HRC applied in a grid pattern.
- Approximately 42 subsurface injections of anaerobic microbes.
- Operation of a truck mounted drilling rig by workers wearing safety gear.
- Operation of the drilling rig may cause noise or vibrations in the immediate vicinity of the drilling location.

There should be no significant disruption of traffic, dust, or other nuisances associated with this work.


