DTSC delays decision on draft Grove Subdivision Cleanup Plan, 3342 Humphrey Road, Loomis

On September 19, 2016, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) ended the public comment period on the draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW). This RAW proposes a soil cleanup for pesticide and metal polluted soil at the Grove Subdivision, 3342 Humphrey Road, Loomis CA 95650. DTSC decided to delay a decision on the draft RAW because we await the Town of Loomis' review and approval of the proposed subdivision.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

DTSC will work with the Town of Loomis to finish a Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration. This CEQA document will not only review the potential effects of the draft RAW but also the potential effects from the Grove Subdivision construction. The Town of Loomis, as the lead for the CEQA process, will have this document available for your review and comment in the future.
