FIVE-YEAR REVIEW FORMER OAKLAND ARMY BASE GATEWAY DEVELOPMENT AREA AND SUBARU LOT OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA 94607

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and the City of Oakland has initiated a Five-Year Review of the remedy for contaminated soil and groundwater at the Gateway Development Area and Subaru Lot within the former Oakland Army Base (Site), in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, California.

The purpose of the Five-Year Review is to evaluate the performance of environmental cleanup actions conducted at the Site to ensure that they remain protective of human health and the environment. Following the evaluation, a Five-Year Review Report will be prepared, which summarizes Site history, cleanup actions, technical assessments, and recommendations regarding the protectiveness of the environmental cleanup actions. The completed Five-Year Review Report and other Site-related documents will be available for public review after **August 31, 2016** at the following information repositories:
