What is the work?

- Removing 11 groundwater monitoring wells and 17 soil gas probes using both hand tools and a truck mounted drill rig.
- Drilling 25 borings and collecting soil samples.
- Filling in bore holes no longer needed.
- Further work happens in 2017.

When will you see work?

- Expected dates: September 12 to 21, 2016.
- Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Where will you see work?

- Throughout the Site.
- Please see the map on the reverse side.

How will the work impact you?

- The work should not impact you.
- All streets open as usual. Workers will close six parking spaces along Pine Street for about four hours.

Who will do the work?

- Contractors for the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, under the oversight of DTSC.
