## Corrective Measures Proposal - Western Tube Facility, Long Beach, California.

**WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?** The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a draft Corrective Measures Proposal (CMP) for the 21 acre Western Tube and Conduit, Inc. facility (Site), located at 2001 East Dominguez Street, Long Beach, Los Angeles County, California.

Soil vapor, soil, and groundwater investigations have been conducted at the Site since January 2009 under DTSC oversight. Volatile organic compounds (VOCs) were detected in the soil vapor and in shallow groundwater (not used for drinking water) during these investigations. The three main constituents of concern detected at the Site were perchloroethylene (PCE) in soil vapor and chloroform, PCE, and 1,4-dioxane in groundwater. The CMP proposes the implementation of a land use covenant (LUC) and Institutional Controls (IC) at the Site. The LUC and IC limit the type of activities and future development so that facilities such as residences, day cares, or hospitals cannot be built, and also require a five-year groundwater monitoring and review plan. The LUC/IC also requires that any future Site activities that would disturb the soil, such as construction activities, be conducted only under supervision of a government agency.

**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA):** DTSC has prepared a CEQA Notice of Exemption (NOE) for this project. The NOE states that the proposed project activities will have no significant impact on the environment.

**HOW DO I PARTICIPATE:** DTSC encourages you to review and provide comments on the draft CMP during the Public Comment Period running from January 14 through February 13, 2013. DTSC will consider all comments before finalizing its decision to approve the CMP.
