

Dr. Patrick Lin is the director of The Nanoethics Group (www.nanoethics.org), a non-partisan and independent organization focused on the social and ethical impact of emerging technologies, especially nanotechnology. He is also a post-doctoral associate at Dartmouth as well as an adjunct faculty member at Western Michigan University. Dr. Lin earned his B.A. from University of California at Berkeley and his M.A. and Ph.D. from University of California at Santa Barbara.

Current projects at The Nanoethics Group include: a \$250,000 grant awarded by the US National Science Foundation to study the ethics of human enhancement and nanotechnology; and an anthology to be published by Wiley this summer, entitled *Nanotechnology: A Maelstrom of Ethical and Social Issues*, with papers from 30 leading experts worldwide that – for the first time in a single source - cover a full range of concerns such as environmental risk, medicine, public engagement, education, privacy, military, developing countries, space exploration, artificial intelligence, life extension and others.
