

Fundamentals (4.I): Permitting/Enforcement EnviroStor Enforcement Data Sharing with the Public

Share all enforcement data with the public through the EnviroStor public web site.

Goal: Improve transparency by sharing all Enforcement data with the public through the EnviroStor public website.

Currently, a portion of DTSC's Enforcement data is available to the public via the US EPA's ECHO data service. Displaying Enforcement data on the EnviroStor website would allow: 1) sharing of all Enforcement information, 2) integration of the Enforcement activities with other DTSC regulatory actions on facilities, and 3) more control over content to highlight program accomplishments.

DTSC proposes a phased approach to displaying enforcement data. The initial phase will include displaying all shareable Enforcement data on the public website. The final website will include summary graphics and other enhancements that will provide information in a fashion that is readily understandable to the public.

Timeline:

April – June 2013:

- Establish workgroup of key Program representatives and develop Project Plan
- Workgroup determines data that can be shared with the public and the best method to display the data

July – September 2013:

- Design and test Interim web display
- Unveil interim web display to public

October 2013 – March 2014:

- Design, create and test final web display
- Solicit feedback from Interested Parties and modify web display based on feedback
- Unveil final web display to public
