DTSC is holding three public workshops on its draft Supplemental Environmental Projects (SEPs) Policy. The SEPs policy is part of DTSC's commitment to environmental justice. DTSC prioritizes the use of SEPs in California's most impacted and vulnerable communities. The goal of the workshops is for DTSC to answer questions and get feedback on the SEPs policy.

What are SEPs?
