



## CLOSURE PLAN CONTENTS AND TECHNICAL REVIEW

### 3.15 - CLOSURE IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE

The owner or operator is required to complete final closure activities in accordance with the approved closure plan within 180 days of receiving the final volume of hazardous wastes at the unit/facility. Therefore, the closure implementation schedule proposed by the facility should not exceed this time limit. There are provisions in CCR, Sections 66264.113 (b) and 66265.113 (b) that allow the Department to grant extensions to this requirement. The facility must submit this extension request at least 30 days before the deadline date.

There are no technical standards to which the permit writer can compare the proposed closure implementation schedule other than "reasonableness". That is, the permit writer should accept the facility's proposed schedule at face value unless there are extenuating circumstances or unreasonable time periods.
