



## CLOSURE PLAN CONTENTS AND TECHNICAL REVIEW

### 3.18 - SITE SECURITY

The closure plan must describe the procedures that will be used to maintain a security system throughout implementation of the closure. The security system should prevent access of persons or livestock onto the facility, unless it can be demonstrated that access will cause no damage to human health or the environment. The following security devices are required at a facility undergoing partial or final closure:

! Signs with the legend "Danger hazardous Waste Area -- Unauthorized Personnel Keep Out" posted at each entrance to the facility or waste management units, and at other locations, in sufficient numbers to be seen from any approach to these units; and

! A fence completely surrounding the facility or waste management units equipped with locked entrances.

Alternatively, a 24-hour surveillance system (e.g., television monitoring or surveillance by guards or facility personnel) which continuously monitors and controls entry onto the facility or waste management units may replace a fence.

The owner or operator should operate the security devices during partial and final closure and until the closure certification is accepted by the Department.
