## Proposed No Further Corrective Action Determination

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: April 23 to June 9, 2008**

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is requesting public comment on a proposed No Further Corrective Action Determination (NFA) for certain areas at Advanced Environmental Incorporated (AEI). AEI is an authorized hazardous waste management facility, where operations include the transferring and storing of used oil, waste antifreeze, oily water, oily contaminated debris, and various other contaminated petroleum products.

The proposed NFA Determination is documented in a Statement of Basis, which summarizes site investigations, the areas at AEI proposed for NFA, and the reasons for the NFA Determination. DTSC encourages you to review the Statement of Basis, which is available at the information repositories listed below and to comment on the proposed NFA.

Several areas at AEI have undergone environmental investigations, and in 2005 AEI submitted a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Final Investigation Report (RFI) which documents the investigations. AEI also submitted a Human Health Risk Assessment (HRA) in 2005, which presents findings regarding risks to onsite workers and nearby residents. The RFI and HRA are both available for public review at the information repositories listed below.

As required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC has reviewed the potential impacts that the proposed NFA Determination could have on the environment, and has determined that there will be no significant negative impacts. This determination has been documented in a CEQA Notice of Exemption (NOE), which will be filed with Governor's Office of Planning and Research.

DTSC encourages your participation during the public comment period. The Statement of Basis, RFI Report, HRA, and NOE are available for you to review at the following information repositories:
