What is being proposed?

The Department of Toxic Substances control invites the public to review and comment on a draft Hazardous Waste Facility permit for Advanced Environmental Inc., (AEI) in Fontana. If approved, the permit will authorize AEI to continue storage and transfer of hazardous used oil, oily waste, wastewater and anti-freeze.

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), a draft Negative Declaration was prepared concluding the proposed hazardous waste permit actions will have no adverse environmental impacts. The draft Negative Declaration is also available for public comment.

How do I participate?

Your participation is encouraged. **The forty-five (45) day public comment period begins March 11, 2005 and ends April 25, 2005.** You may comment on the draft hazardous waste permit and draft Negative Declaration by sending in written or e-mailed comments no later than **April 25, 2005** to:
