Draft Closure Plan and Corrective Action Termination

What's being proposed?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites public comments during the 30-day public comment period which runs from June 29, to July 29, 2005, on the Closure Plan and Corrective Action Termination for American Recovery Inc. (ARI). The now closed (ARI) facility was in the business of Storage, treatment, and transfer of hazardous waste at 3033 W. Mission Road, in Alhambra.

The facility operated under a temporary permit to treat and store solvents and hazardous substances from a variety of waste streams from 1978 to the year 2000. In the year 2000, DTSC denied the ARI hazardous waste permit application, which terminated the temporary status and resulted in the forced closure of all hazardous waste units at the Facility.

How do I participate?

You are invited to review and comment on the documents known as the Draft Closure Plan, Draft Corrective Measures Study and Corrective Action Completion Termination. DTSC has made an analysis of the environmental effects of these modifications as shown in the draft CEQA Negative Declaration and Initial Study. A Notice of Determination (NOD) will be filed with the State Clearinghouse upon completion of the formal permit review process.
