This letter is to inform you that the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received your October 30, 2007 and September 27, 2007 revisions to the Hazardous Waste Operation Plan (Revised OP) for your hazardous waste storage and treatment facility (RCRA-C and RCRA-J) located at Highway 50 and Aerojet Road in Rancho Cordova, Sacramento County (facility).

You submitted a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Renewal Operation Plan to DTSC on August 15, 2006. After review the application for technical completeness, DTSC sent you a Notice of Deficiency letter on August 20, 2007.

DTSC has carefully reviewed your Revised OP. DTSC concludes that the OP is now administratively and technically completed. This means that DTSC will initiate to prepare a hazardous waste facility permit (Permit). DTSC will also prepare a Statement

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of Findings for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) The draft Permit, the CEQA Notice of Findings will be public noticed in the near future.
