The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received the latest revision of your Standardized Permit Application titled, "Standardized Permit Application for Bakersfield Transfer, Inc., dated November 20, 2007" for the Bakersfield Transfer, Inc. facility located at 1620 East Brundage Lane in Bakersfield, California. The Standardized Permit Application was signed on June 15, 2007.

Pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Section 66271.2, DTSC has reviewed the application and found it to be technically complete. A Draft Permit and draft Negative Declaration has been prepared based on this application. The public notice announcing the start of the public comment period for the Draft Permit and draft Negative Declaration will be issued on December 3, 2007. A public hearing will be held on January 8, 2008 at the Kern County Library Branch at 506 East Brundage Lane in Bakersfield. The 45-day public comment period will end on January 16, 2008. At the conclusion of the public comment period, If DTSC determines that additional information is needed to clarify, modify, or supplement previously submitted material, DTSC reserves the right to require this information from Bakersfield Transfer, Inc.
