Notice of Public Comment Period

**Blue Hills Disposal Facility
Draft Post-Closure Permit
West Fresno County, California**

Public Comment Period: July 18, 2007 through September 4, 2007

The initial public notice that was placed in the newspaper by the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) erroneously indicated the 45-day public comment ending on August 4, 2007. To meet the required 45-days, the public comment ends on September 4, 2007.

What is being proposed?

DTSC invites you to comment on a draft Post-Closure Permit for the Blue Hills Disposal Facility, a closed hazardous waste disposal area, located approximately 10 miles northeast of Coalinga in Fresno County.

DTSC is the state agency responsible for regulating the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. If approved, the renewed permit would require long-term monitoring of the closed hazardous waste disposal facility.

As part of the permit process, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed draft post-closure permit as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption in connection with this project.

A 45-day public comment period is from July 18, 2007 to September 4, 2007. Written comments must be postmarked or emailed by September 4, 2007 and sent to:
