20 Plaintiff, the People of the State of California, having filed its Complaint herein; and  
21 Defendant California Steel Industries, Inc., having accepted service thereof; and Plaintiff appearing  
22 through its attorney Michael A. Ramos, District Attorney of the County of San Bernardino, by R.  
23 Glenn Yabuno, Deputy District Attorney; and Defendant appearing through their attorneys,  
24 MORGAN LEWIS & BOCKIUS LLP, by Andrea Sheridan Ordin; and

25 Plaintiff and said Defendant having stipulated and consented to the entry of this Judgment  
26 prior to the taking of any proof, without trial or adjudication of any fact or law and without any  
27 admission of liability; and

28 The Court having considered the pleadings;

29 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff, the People of the  
30 State of California, have judgment against Defendant, as follows:



1 4. Defendant shall, for a period of three years of the date of this Judgment, be required  
2 to:

- 3 (a) Keep all records and logs on-site and available for inspection, during  
4 normal business hours;
- 5 (b) Notify the San Bernardino County Fire Department/Hazardous Materials  
6 Division and OES of any reportable off-site discharge;
- 7 (c) Maintain all containment ponds to prevent unauthorized off-site releases.  
8

9 MONETARY RELIEF

10 5. Defendant is ordered to pay a total amount of \$185,800.00 to the District Attorney of  
11 the County of San Bernardino as Supplemental Environmental Projects, investigative cost  
12 reimbursement and civil penalties. That amount shall be apportioned as follows: \$135,800.00 as  
13 investigative cost reimbursement, \$25,000.00 as Supplemental Environmental Projects and  
14 \$25,000.00 as civil penalties.

15 6. All payments made to the District Attorney's Office pursuant to this Final Judgment  
16 shall be made payable to the Office of the District Attorney, 412 W. Hospitality Lane, Suite 301, San  
17 Bernardino, California 92315. Judgment pursuant to this paragraph shall be paid upon the following  
18 terms and conditions:

- 19 (a) Defendant shall pay the total amount within thirty (30) days of the date of  
20 entry of this Judgment;

21 7. In the event of default by Defendant the balance shall become immediately payable in  
22 full. The balance due shall accrue interest at the rate of ten percent (10%) per year, until paid in full.  
23 Plaintiff shall be entitled to reasonable fees and costs incurred in collecting any payments due and  
24 owing subsequent to such default.

25 COMPLIANCE

26 8. Defendant shall permit duly-authorized representatives of the San Bernardino County  
27 District Attorney's Office, the San Bernardino County Fire Department/Hazardous Materials  
28 Division, California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), California Department of  
29 Fish and Game and Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board to access all of their sites and  
30

1 facilities at reasonable times and places and, without interference of any kind, allow representatives  
2 of those agencies, to interview agents, employees or representatives of Defendant regarding  
3 compliance with term # 3 of this Stipulated Judgment

4 9. Service upon Defendant's attorney, Andrea Sheridan Ordin, shall constitute sufficient  
5 and complete notice of the terms of this Final Judgment and Injunction.

6 RETENTION OF JURISDICTION

7 10. Jurisdiction is retained by this Court for the purpose of enabling either party to this  
8 Final Judgment to apply to the Court at any time for such further orders and direction as may be  
9 necessary and appropriate for the carrying out of this Final Judgment, and/or the construction,  
10 modification or termination of the injunctive provisions herein, as well as for the enforcement of  
11 compliance with this Final Judgment and for the punishment of violations thereof.
