NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION

June 25, 2010

In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.1(c)(5)&(6), the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is providing this notification of final decision that the following facility has demonstrated and meets the requirements for closure by decontamination or removal:

Chemical Waste Management Inc., Bakersfield (Facility)
27001 Round Mountain Road
Bakersfield, CA 93309
USEPA ID Number CAT000624056

No comments were filed during the 30 day public comment period for the draft decision pertaining to this closure, held from May 10, 2010 to June 9, 2010. This decision becomes effective immediately upon recording of a land use covenant agreed upon by DTSC. This decision means that the Facility's Post-Closure Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (HWFP) dated April 30, 1991 is no longer required, and that the Facility is not required to renew future Post-Closure HWFPs with DTSC. Through site characterization and human and ecological risk assessment, DTSC has determined that management of the site through implementation of a land use covenant and continued oversight from the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board will provide appropriate protection of human health and the environment. DTSC will confirm compliance with the terms of the land use covenant through annual site inspections and annual reports provided to DTSC.
