NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION

To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Decision (Notice) for the following facility:

Chevron El Segundo Refinery
324 West El Segundo Boulevard
El Segundo, California 90245

On December 14, 2006, DTSC informed the public of a 60-day public comment period on the Draft Permit and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Draft Negative Declaration. That comment period ran from December 14, 2006 through February 13, 2007. A public hearing was held on January 23, 2007 at the El Segundo Public Library, 111 West Mariposa Avenue, El Segundo, California. Comments were received during the public hearing.

Other comments were also received during the public comment period and by electronic and postal mail. DTSC has prepared a Response to Comments document and made changes to the Permit. A copy of the Response to Comments document has been sent to each commenter. The Response to Comments document, the DTSC memorandum to file that lists the revisions made to the Draft Permit in response to public comments, a redline/strikeout version of the Final Permit showing all the changes from the Draft to the Final Permit, and the Final Permit are available to the public at the repositories listed at the end of this notice.

In its role as Lead Agency under the provisions of the CEQA, DTSC prepared a Negative Declaration to evaluate impacts from the proposed project and identify migration measures.

Within 30 days after a final permit decision has been issued under California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14, any person who filed comments on that draft permit or who participated in the public hearing may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or who failed to participate in the public hearing on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft permit to the final permit decision. The 30-day period within which a person may request review under section 66271.18 begins on Monday, April 16, 2007, and ends on Wednesday, May 16, 2007. The permit becomes effective on May 17, 2007, unless a petition for review is filed. Such petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period. When appropriate, the petition must show that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, at its discretion, review.
