CHEVRON PRODUCTS COMPANY Draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Renewal El Segundo, California

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: December 14, 2006 to February 13, 2007

WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a draft permit renewal for the hazardous waste facility at the Chevron El Segundo Refinery. The Chevron El Segundo Refinery is located at 324 W. El Segundo Blvd., El Segundo, California 90245.

DTSC is the state agency responsible for regulating the generation, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste in California. The hazardous waste facility and landfarm (a closed hazardous waste treatment facility), were originally permitted in 1987. If approved, the renewed permit will allow Chevron to continue to store and treat hazardous waste on the refinery property and will also allow continued post-closure care of the closed landfarm. As part of the permit process, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed draft permit renewal as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Negative Declaration in connection with this project.

The 60-day public comment period is from December 14, 2006 to February 13, 2007. The usual 45-day comment period will be extended to allow additional response time during the holiday season.
