FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION

In accordance with the requirements of Title 22, California Code of Regulations (22 CCR), Section 66271.14, the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is hereby issuing a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit to the following:

The decision to issue the final permit becomes effective on July 24, 2010 unless a review is requested under 22 CCR 66271.18. This action constitutes a final permit decision under 22 CCR 66271.14 and Section 25200 of the California Health and Safety Code. The waste management activities governed by this permit are limited to the delay closure of an Integrated Wastewater Pond System which is allowed to store non-hazardous wastewater until its final closure.

This decision may be appealed in accordance with 22 CCR 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the proposed permit may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the permit. Any persons who failed to file comments on the proposed permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the proposed to the final permit. Please note there is a change in Part II.8 of the final permit as a result of the DTSC's financial review. The cost estimate for the post closure is now listed in Part II.8 of the final permit and the closure cost estimate was revised from 58 million to 80.6 million dollars.

The 30-day period within which a person may request review begins June 24, 2010 and ends July 23, 2010. In order to satisfy this requirement, the petition must be postmarked no later than July 23, 2010. The petition must be sent to DTSC at the following location:

The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period (including the public hearing) and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

- 1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous or
- 2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in discretion, review.
