



NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD



Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Renewal for Chico Drain Oil Service Fortuna Facility 200 Dinsmore Drive, Fortuna, CA

Public Comment Period: June 30 to August 17, 2009

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on the Draft Renewal Standardized Permit, Series C (Permit) for the Chico Drain Oil Service – Fortuna Facility (Chico Drain Oil) at 200 Dinsmore Drive in Fortuna. Approval of the Permit will allow Chico Drain Oil to continue operating a hazardous waste storage facility.

The facility collects used oil from offsite generators (gas stations, oil changers, auto repair shops, etc.) and consolidates the used oil in one storage tank at the facility before shipping it to a hazardous waste treatment or disposal facility. Used oil is required to be managed as hazardous waste. DTSC evaluated any possible environmental impacts associated with the proposed activities of Chico Drain Oil as required by the CEQA. DTSC has prepared a Notice of Exemption which states that the continued operations of the Hazardous Waste Facility would not have any impacts to human health and the environment.
