The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received the latest revision of your Standardized Permit Application titled, " Operation Plan, Standardized Permit Renewal Application for Chico Drain Oil Service, LLC, 200 Dinsmore Drive, Fortuna, California 95540, May 2009", for the Used Oil Transfer Facility at 200 Dinsmore Drive in Fortuna, California. The Renewal Permit Application was signed on May 29, 2009.

Pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Section 66271.2, DTSC has reviewed the application and found it to be technically complete. A Draft Permit and draft Notice of Exemption has been prepared based on this application. The public notice announcing the start of the public comment period for the Draft Permit will be issued on June 30, 2009. The 45-day public comment period will end on August 17, 2009. At the conclusion of the public comment period, if DTSC determines that additional information is needed to clarify, modify, or supplement previously submitted material, DTSC reserves the right to require this information from Chico Drain Oil Service.
