The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made a final permit decision to issue the Standardized Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit), for the Chico Drain Oil Service – Fortuna facility at 200 Dinsmore Drive in Fortuna, California.
