**NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT DECISION –
CHICO DRAIN OIL SERVICE – FORTUNA, 200 DINSMORE DRIVE,
FORTUNA, CALIFORNIA, EPA ID No. CAL 930256136**

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Notice of Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Decision (Notice) for the following facility:

Chico Drain Oil Service – Fortuna
200 Dinsmore Drive
Fortuna, California 90746
EPA ID No. CAL 930256136

This Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit authorizes Chico Drain Oil Service to store and transfer used oil and contaminated with oil at its facility located 200 Dinsmore Drive in Fortuna, California. On June 30, 2009, DTSC published a public notice in the Times-Standard to announce the start of a 45-day public comment period to solicit comments on the Draft Permit. Copies of a fact sheet were mailed to the facility mailing list. A paid public notice announcing the public comment period was aired on a local radio station. The public comment period ended on August 17, 2009. One public comment was received by electronic mail.

DTSC has prepared a Response to the Comments (RTC) document and made some minor changes to the Draft Permit for clarification purposes. The Final Hazardous Waste Facility Permit becomes effective on October 16, 2009 unless a review is requested pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the draft permit or participated in the public hearing may petition DTSC to review any conditions of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period to the extent required by the regulations and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on:

1. A finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous, or
2. An exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review.
