SUBJECT: CHANGES FROM DRAFT PERMIT TO FINAL PERMIT

Following is a summary of changes from the draft to Final Permit. A redline/ strikeout version of the document that shows these changes is in the file.

1. Administrative Changes Applicable to the Entire Permit:
 - a. Inserted effective date as November 27, 2007 and expiration date as November 26, 2017 on cover page of Permit.
 - b. Made Table of Contents as part of Attachment A. This resulted in a permit having 38 pages instead of 36.
 - c. Updated Table of Contents to reflect correct page numbers as a result of moving the Table of Contents to Attachment A.
 - d. Changed number of pages and added the effective date of the Permit in the header of Permit. Also, removed "Draft" in the header.
 - e. Corrected typographical errors throughout the Permit.
 - f. Re-worded several sentences for clarity.
 - g. Corrected citations and citation form.
2. Specific Changes from the Draft to Final Permit:
 - a. Removed Draft from cover page of Permit. Added Health and Safety Code section 25200 to cover page as citation for issuing permit. Changed "Series A Standardized Hazardous Waste Facility Permit" to "Standardized Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, Series A."
 - b. Added "Attachment A" to Table of Content page.
 - c. Removed "Attachment A" and "Draft" from Page 3.

- d. Page V, Condition 12, Changed “Any non-hazardous waste placed within the Storage and Transfer Unit must be included in the volume calculation for the secondary containment capacity.” to “Any non-hazardous waste placed within the Storage and Transfer Unit must be included in the volume calculation for the secondary containment capacity.”
- e. Page VI, Condition 1.(c), Changed “Within 45 days from receiving the soil chemical analysis from the laboratory, the Permittee shall submit to DTSC a report showing the results of analysis of the soil samples taken to determine if further corrective action is required.” to “Within 45 days from receiving the soil chemical analysis from the laboratory, the Permittee shall submit to DTSC a report showing the results of analysis of the soil samples taken to determine if further corrective action is required.”
- f. Appendix 1, Corrected dates of Standardized Permit Application in caption.
