## CleanTech Environmental Inc. Notice of Public Comment Period for the Draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit and Notice of Availability for the Draft Environmental Impact Report

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: August 11, 2014 to September 26, 2014**

**What Is Being Proposed?** The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces the start of the public comment period for the draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit and draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for CleanTech Environmental Inc. CleanTech is located at 5820 Martin Road in Irwindale. DTSC welcomes comments from the public on the draft Permit and draft EIR. DTSC is the regulatory agency considering approval of a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit for CleanTech under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC is the lead regulatory agency for the preparation of the EIR. If approved as proposed, the CleanTech permit would allow the construction and operation of a hazardous waste storage and treatment facility.

CleanTech proposes to receive used oil, a California designated hazardous waste at their existing 0.98 acre site located within a commercial/industrial area of Irwindale. The used oil will be tested, stored and treated to meet the recycled oil standards in California law. CleanTech would also receive, and store waste antifreeze, oil contaminated solid waste, and non-RCRA wastewater. The draft EIR found no significant and unavoidable impacts from the proposed project's construction and operation, but several mitigation measures are required to reduce potentially significant impacts to cultural resources, greenhouse gases, hazardous materials, noise, traffic, and water quality. The draft EIR also includes an evaluation of alternatives to the proposed project. DTSC's final decision on the Hazardous Waste Facility Permit will occur after completion of the public comment period on the draft permit and the CEQA environmental review.
