Public Comment Period: December 30, 2013 to January 31, 2014

What Is Being Proposed? The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces a 30 day public comment period for the Notice of Preparation (NOP) for a draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for CleanTech. The NOP is available for public review and comment. The purpose of the NOP is to solicit guidance from agencies and stakeholders for the scope and content of environmental information to be included in the draft Environmental Impact Report. DTSC is the lead regulatory agency for the approval of a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit for the CleanTech Environmental Inc., pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

DTSC determined an EIR should be prepared to evaluate environmental impacts and analyze the alternatives. CleanTech, located at 5820 Martin Road in Irwindale, covers 0.98 acres within a commercial/industrial area of Irwindale. CleanTech is proposing to receive used oil, a California designated hazardous waste. The used oil will be tested, stored and treated to meet the recycled oil standards in California law. CleanTech would also receive, and store waste antifreeze, oil contaminated solid waste, and non-RCRA wastewater. If approved, the CleanTech permit would allow the construction and operation of a hazardous waste storage and treatment facility.

Upcoming Public Scoping Meetings: Two Public Scoping Meetings will be held. The first will be on Tuesday, January 14th, at 3:00 pm, at the Duarte Library Meeting Room, 1301 Buena Vista Street, Duarte, California 91010, and is targeted for public agencies, but all are welcome. The second public scoping meeting will also be held Tuesday, January 14th, at 6:30 pm, at the City of Irwindale Community Center, 16102 Arrow Highway, Irwindale, 91706.
