NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY POST CLOSURE PERMIT DECISION

To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14 (22 CCR 66271.14), the California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this final decision to issue a Post Closure Permit for the Stormwater Holding Basin 2 (SHB 2) to:

The public comment period for the draft Post Closure Permit started on May 20, 2008 and ended on July 3, 2008. Public notices were placed in the Daily Breeze and La Opinion on May 20, 2008. The radio announcement was aired on 93.5 AM KDAY on May 20, 2008. A Public Meeting was held at the Wilmington Public Library, 1300 N. Avalon Blvd., Wilmington, California 90744 on June 10, 2008. DTSC received no verbal or written comments concerning the proposed draft Post Closure Permit.

The final Permit and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Notice of Exemption (NOE) were signed and issued on July 24, 2008. This action constitutes a final permit decision under 22 CCR 66271.14(a) and the permit became effective on July 24, 2008.
