The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed the technical review of the Closure Plan and Post Closure Permit Application dated January 30, 2009 with additional revisions dated September 18, 2009, and January 8, 2010 for the Primary Storm Basin at the ConocoPhillips San Francisco Refinery, 1380 San Pablo Avenue, Rodeo, California 94572.

DTSC considers the Closure Plan and the Post Closure Permit Application listed above to be technically complete. DTSC has also drafted a Notice of Exemption for the closure plan approval and the post closure permit to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act.

The draft Permit and Administrative Record will be made available for public review and comment during the comment period. DTSC will also hold a public meeting prior to the issuance of a final permit decision. If DTSC determines that additional information is needed to clarify, modify or supplement previously submitted material, DTSC reserves the right to require this information from ConocoPhillips. You will soon receive a notice of public comment period and public meeting for the closure plan approval and the draft permit.
