### NOTICE OF FINAL HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY CLOSURE PLAN APPROVAL AND POST-CLOSURE PERMIT DECISION FOR PRIMARY STORM BASIN, CONOCOPHILLIPS COMPANY, SAN FRANCISCO REFINERY, RODEO, CALIFORNIA, EPA ID NUMBER CAD 009108705

#### To Interested Parties:

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has made a final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility Closure Plan Approval and the Post Closure Permit for the Primary Storm Basin at the ConocoPhillips San Francisco Refinery, 1380 San Pablo Avenue, Rodeo, California 94572. The Final Closure Plan Approval and the Final Post Closure Permit is issued by DTSC in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, sections 66264.112 and 66271.14.

In accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.42(c), DTSC sent a notice of the draft Closure Plan and draft Post Closure Permit to all persons on the facility mailing list and appropriate units of State and local government. Public notices were placed in the West County Newspaper a subsidiary of the Contra Costa Times and a radio announcement was also made in the KGO am radio.

The public comment period for the draft Closure Plan and the draft Post Closure Permit began on August 25, 2011 and ended on October 14, 2011. A Public Meeting was held on October 6, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at the Rodeo Senior Center, 189 Parker Avenue, Rodeo, California. DTSC received a comment from the Regional Water Board by an e-mail on September 8, 2011 and from ConocoPhillips on October 14, 2011.

The final Permit becomes effective on February 21, 2012 unless a review is requested pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.18. Within 30 days after a final permit decision is issued, any person who filed comments on that draft closure plan and the draft permit may petition DTSC to review any condition of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments on the draft permit may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the draft permit to the final permit. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period (including any public hearing) and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on: (1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is

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clearly erroneous; or 2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should, in its discretion, review. The Permit shall take effect on the effective date if DTSC does not receive any petition within the 30-day period which ends on February 21, 2012.
