PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: JUNE 4, 2014 - JULY 21, 2014

WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED? The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on the draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Renewal (Permit) for Crosby & Overton, Inc. (The Facility) located at 1630 West 17th Street in Long Beach, California 90813. The Facility is an off-site hazardous waste storage and treatment facility that accepts hazardous wastes in bulk and containers. The Facility primarily treats oily wastewater in their tank treatment system. The Facility has several container storage areas and container processing units. A Permit enables DTSC to effectively regulate the hazardous waste management activities at facilities. Permits are developed after DTSC's detailed technical review, and are intended to ensure that facilities operate in a manner that protects human health and the environment.

As part of the permit process, DTSC is required to evaluate any possible environmental impacts associated with this project as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on this review, DTSC has determined that the proposed draft permit will not have any significant effects on public health or the environment. DTSC proposes to issue a CEQA Negative Declaration in connection with this project. The public comment period starts on **June 4, 2014 to July 21, 2014**. All written comments must be received by **July 21, 2014**.
