



NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Draft Corrective Measures Proposal and Closure of the Wastewater Treatment Unit for the Former Battery Plant located in Anaheim at 1201 North Magnolia Avenue

30-Day PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD August 17, 2007 through September 17, 2007

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites the public to review and comment on a Corrective Measures Proposal (CMP) and Closure Plan for the former Delphi Battery Operations (Delphi) site located at 1201 North Magnolia Avenue in Anaheim. This 22-acre site is located on the west side of Magnolia Avenue between Woodland Drive and south of the 5 Freeway in an industrial use area. The site was used for the fabrication of lead acid batteries since the 1960s. The property will likely be redeveloped for commercial/industrial use. The proposed cleanup plan for this site is presented in the CMP and consists of removing contaminated shallow soils in several areas, extracting soil vapor, monitoring groundwater, and implementing an agreement called a "covenant" that ensures the land will only be used for commercial/industrial activities in the future. Also available for review is a Closure Plan for an onsite wastewater treatment unit previously operated under interim status authorized by DTSC and United States Environmental Protection Agency. The public will have 30 days to provide comments to the DTSC.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) we are required to evaluate all proposed projects to determine if they could have significant adverse environmental impacts. DTSC has determined that the proposed project will not have a significant adverse impact.
