## DRAFT HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY PERMIT AND PROPOSED CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT NEGATIVE DECLARATION DK Environmental

Vernon, California

**Public Comment Period: July 12, 2012 to August 28, 2012**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites public comments on the draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) for DK Environmental (DKE) located at 3650 E. 26th Street in Vernon, California. Approval of the Permit would allow DKE to transfer and store hazardous wastes at the facility. The facility and surrounding area are zoned for heavy industrial and commercial land uses. There are no residences within a half mile radius of the facility.

The facility is now requesting to store hazardous wastes in containers/drums in a newly built container storage area and continue the railcar activities, which were authorized under the Consent Order Number HWCA 2004-0437, issued by DTSC in January 2007. If approved, the term of the new Permit will be 10 years.

DTSC would like to solicit comments on the proposed California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Negative Declaration (Neg Dec), which finds the project not having any significant effect on human health and the environment. The Administrative Record which includes but not limited to the draft Permit, Permit Application, and related CEQA documents are available for public review at the following repositories shown below.
