NOTICE OF CLASS 1* PERMIT MODIFICATION

David H. Fell Inc. (DHF) has applied to the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for a Class 1 Permit Modification to the facility's hazardous waste facility permit. DHF is a Precious metal reclamation facility, that reclaims silver, Gold, and other precious metals from off-site generated Hazardous waste. The facility is located at 6009 Bandini Boulevard, Bell, CA 90040. DHF will be modifying, their Closure Plan to change the Closure Process for two units: Screen # 2 and Gas furnace #22. Each unit will be placed in a poly ethylene container (6' x 5' x 6"). A pressurized hose will be used to rinse each unit. After rinsing, 2 wipe samples from each unit will be taken and tested for lead, copper, silver, zinc and nickel. The rinse solution will be sampled (2 samples) and tested for lead, copper, silver, zinc and nickel. The rinse solution will then be removed from the container using a vacuum machine. Any rinse solution not sucked up by the vacuum will be removed using scoops and a bucket. The rinse solution will be sent to the Evaporator unit on site and processed through the permitted units at the facility to recover any precious metals. Screen #2 and Gas Furnace #22 will be sent to the David H. Fell facility located at 545 Vortex Road, Northeast in Rio Rancho, New Mexico. The closure performance standard for the samples will be non-detect.
