

**Public Notice of Class 1 Permit Modification

DeMenno-Kerdoon (DK) owns and operates a hazardous waste storage, treatment, recycling, and transfer facility that recycles used oil, waste oil, anti-freeze, and oily water. DK's activities are regulated under a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit issued by the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC). DK recently submitted a Class 1 permit modification notice to the DTSC permitting team in Chatsworth, California, at the address listed below.

The permit modification makes clarifications to DK's permit with respect to tanks used for recovered oil and intermediate waste stream (oil), as well as other administrative and informational changes and corrections of typographical errors. In general, the permit modification is necessary to accurately reflect the primary and secondary operational uses of the tanks within Unit 4. The modification also clarifies that recovered oil may be transferred from Unit 13 to Unit 4 or to Tank D-204 in Unit 6 (both of which currently process recovered oil). The modification also makes administrative changes regarding Unit 17 to clarify that it is for loading and unloading and subject to applicable air-emissions standards.

The permit modification will not require the addition of units or a change in treatment processes or management standards and will not alter or require the alteration of the allowable waste characteristics currently listed in the facility's permit.
